The Bowen family has turned Coonawarra tradition upside down, from their pruning regime to picking time and barrel maturation. The result is the most distinctive and appealing Red wines from the Region.

2005 Bowen Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

91 pts Saturated red. Varietally accurate redcurrant and bitter cherry aromas are complicated by cured tobacco and smoky minerals. Juicy and pliant, with deep cherry and bitter chocolate flavors, silky tannins and a late note of black raspberry. The tannins gain strength on the finish but the fruit keeps pace. The finishing minerality bodes well for cellaring. *Stephen Tanzer's International Wine Cellar, Sept/Oct2008*

2003 Bowen Estate Shiraz

91 pts "Dark red. Aromas of sweet tobacco, smoked meat, black raspberry, violet and cracked pepper; in a distinctly Northern Rhone style. Tactile and chewy, with flavors of ripe berry, licorice, roasted coffee and bitter chocolate. Finishes lush, with smooth, absorbed tannins and excellent concentration. This estate prefers to harvest on the late side, in order to achieve maximum complexity. It seems to work." *Stephen Tanzer's International Wine Cellar, August 2005*
