2005 Hill of Content Shiraz, Western Australia 57%, South Australia 43%

This is the 6th Release of this 100% Shiraz combines the pepper and spice of the cooler vineyards of southwest Western Australia, with the rich dark characters of South Australia's Clare Valley. The palate is lush and intensely flavored, with great balance and elegance. A very seductive wine.



Hill of Content Sparkling Red NV

This Sparkler of a wine is made predominantly from Shiraz sourced from Padthaway, south of Adelaide. The base wine was aged in French oak for 2 ½ years, giving it a wonderful lush and dense character. We chose to bottle the wine under Crown Seal to ensure maximum freshness and sparkle. It also makes it easy to open. Enjoy with family and friends. Ideal as an aperitif. JL
