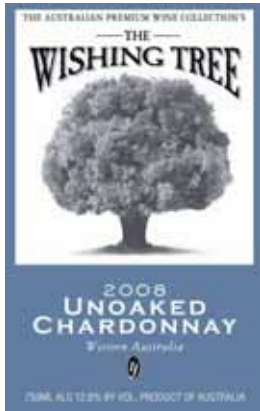




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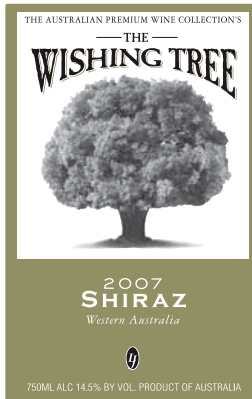

## 2008 The Wishing Tree Unoaked Chardonnay

**88pts** “Pale yellow. Pungent aromas of peach and melon are underscored by a note of lemon zest. Light in body but fleshy, with deep pit fruit and melon flavors and a late kick of tarragon. The finish repeats the lemon zest note and is refreshingly tight and brisk.” *Stephen Tanzer’s International Wine Cellar, Sep/Oct 09*



## 2007 The Wishing Tree Shiraz

**88pts** “Medium red color. Spicy black raspberry and cherry aromas are complemented by notes of white pepper and rose; smells a bit like a grenache. Gently sweet, fresh red and dark berry flavors are brisk and focused, displaying good back-end lift and energy. Finishes on a sweet blackberry note, with good clinging sweetness. This could handle a light chill.” *Stephen Tanzer’s International Wine Cellar, Sep/Oct 09*



## 2005 The Wishing Tree Cabernet Merlot

For those wishing for a rich and intensely favored Cabernet & Merlot blend, this is the wine for you. Beautiful red Cabernet fruits and soft Merlot characters are in abundance.
